## Do Contronics dry misting systems spread the coronavirus?

The virus spreads when people cough, or sneeze, droplets into the air. These droplets are the mucus that lines our airways. Mucus contains salt and minerals, which allows the virus to (briefly) survive outside the body.

### Pure water

The microscopically small droplets in dry mist systems consist of pure water. They do not contain any salt, minerals, bacteria, or viruses. This is guaranteed by the water purifier which is a component in each system. The water's purity is continuously monitored. If there is the slightest chance of contamination, the whole system automatically shuts down.

### Ozone

There is currently no evidence to suggest that the coronavirus can spread through water droplets (European Centre for Disease Prevention).

Additionally, our systems are equipped with an ozone generator. Ozone damages the protein structure of the virus, preventing it from multiplying and therefore neutralising it.

Ozone is currently being widely used in China as a sanitiser.

**To summarise, dry mist does not spread the virus. In fact, it even helps to contain it.**
